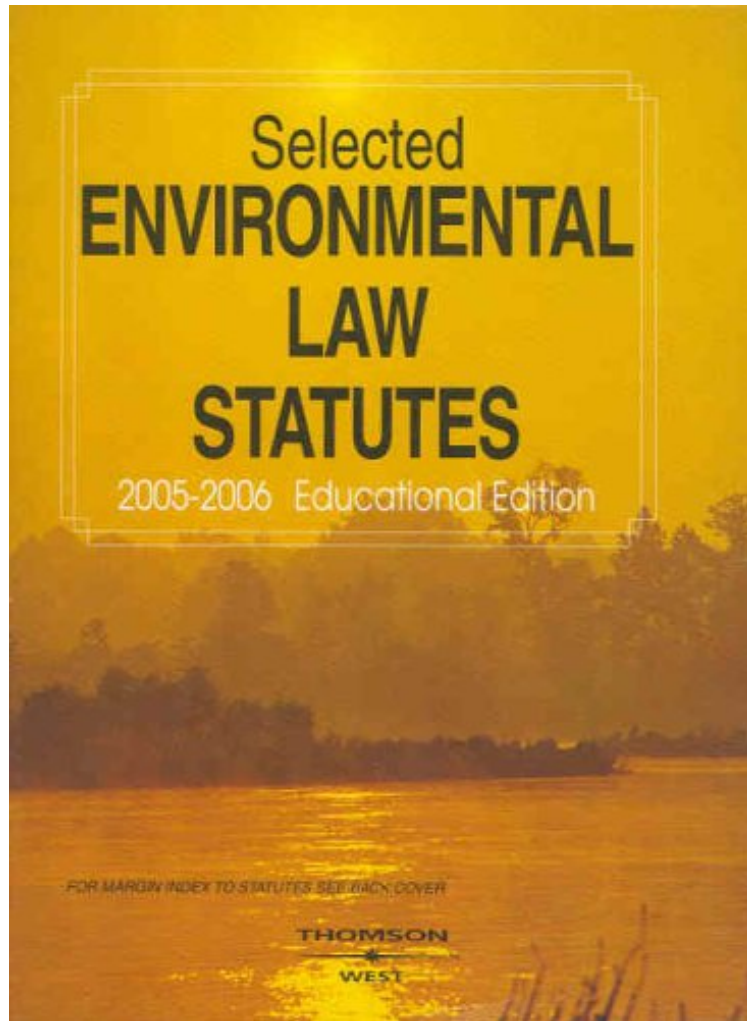

Anyone who needs to have a handy reference of all the basic environmental statutes should have this book. It is primarily published for students in law schools and environmental engineering programs, so it is in paperback and kept relatively affordable. It is cheap enough you can buy the new editions each year, as laws are

amended. My copies are well worn. In addition to the essential statutes (regulating air and water pollution, hazardous waste disposal and cleanup, etc.), it also includes the essential Administrative Procedure Act, which governs so much of the litigation under these laws, and the regulations for the National Environmental Policy Act, which are the real source of law for NEPA since the statute itself says almost nothing. I have practiced environmental law for over twenty years.
