It ultimately gets the job done, but it doesn't add much value as opposed to copying will forms out of book. As a piece of software, however, I can say without hesitation that it is substandard. As I commented on an earlier version of the program, it doesn't have any awareness of multiple users on a PC and administrative privileges versus a normal user. I had to install it as administrator, which is a common requirement, but I also have to use it as administrator. Mistry earned his JD from the Walter F. George School of Law at Mercer University and is a member of the New York State Bar. His other books that are equally successful include several in the Legal Self-Help Guide series: "8 Living Trust Forms," "Give Through a Will Living Trust," "Guidance On Creating Your Own Will and Power of Attorney," and his bestseller book "Will, Trust, Power of Attorney Creator and Estate Records Organizer." They should become indispensable volumes for every astute household. The aspect of Sanket Mistry's books that makes them so valuable is his manner of writing (perhaps he gained those skills in his gaining a BA in philosophy from Emory University and an MIA from Columbia University. And perhaps it is because he actually cares about helping people through this difficult process of planning our end. As he so warmly phrases his purpose in presenting this book, "This resource contains virtually everything you need to prepare your own simple will. Use this reference as part of your overall estate plan. It includes a standard will, called a "Last Will and Testament." It also includes self-proving affidavits and a checklist to help you make the sample forms, legal documents. This book can be used by individuals and married couples. The topics covered include How to distribute property, How to name beneficiaries, Other ways to own property, What to do with your will after you have created it, Important marital and minor children considerations, and more." In addition to offering us the opportunity to take care of creating a Will on our own, he does carefully describe the pitfalls we may encounter, suggests when we need legal counsel, and offers appendices that list definition of legal terms, the variations among different states as to laws and rules, and where to seek further information. There are copies of forms to use with careful instructions for each entry item.
