A slim book where the author continually pats himself on the back and keeps repeating himself. The constant moralizing gets tedious. A more even handed approach would have helped. Underneath there is an interesting story (but it can be more easily gleaned from other (often free) sources). The author also seems to believe DNA testing is infallible. Nothing is infallible. There is no reliable way of determining when DNA may have been left at a crime scene and it can be manufactured (for just two examples).
