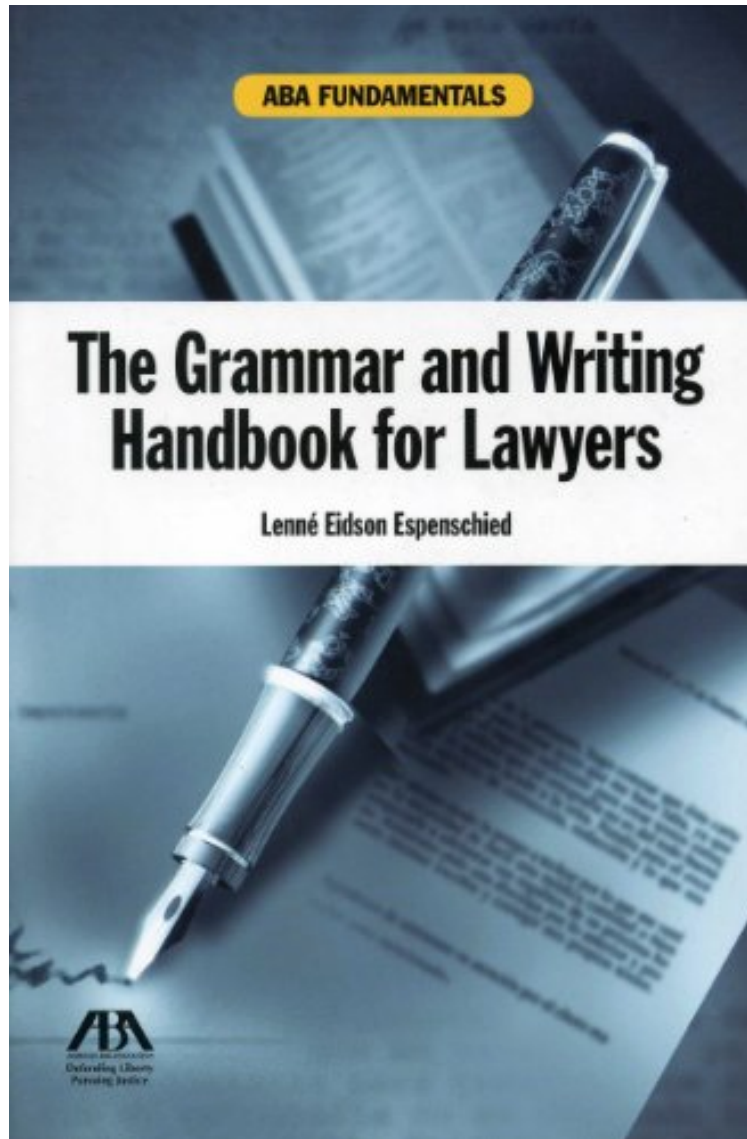

The second sentence of page 1 discusses "the verbal communication system we use everyday." In this sentence, "everyday" is describing how we "use" the verbal communication system. Thus, it is operating as an adverb. In that usage, the phrase "every day" should have been used. Without the space, the word "everyday" is an adjective. For example, "the everyday communication system that we use" would be another valid option. The author's sentence, as published, is simply incorrect. Page 8 discusses "language in its purist forms." The author appears to mean the common phrase "purest forms," not to be attempting some sophisticated wordplay by using the noun "purist" as an adjective. That's two errors in the first eight pages of this book, which purports to show "precisely which rules need to be followed, how to choose the correct words, and the most effective way to structure every sentence." The author clearly does not know those things -- or at least was not able to use them consistently in the first 8 pages of the book. Accordingly, this book cannot be trusted to live up to its promises, and I am still searching for an expert-level book on grammar.
