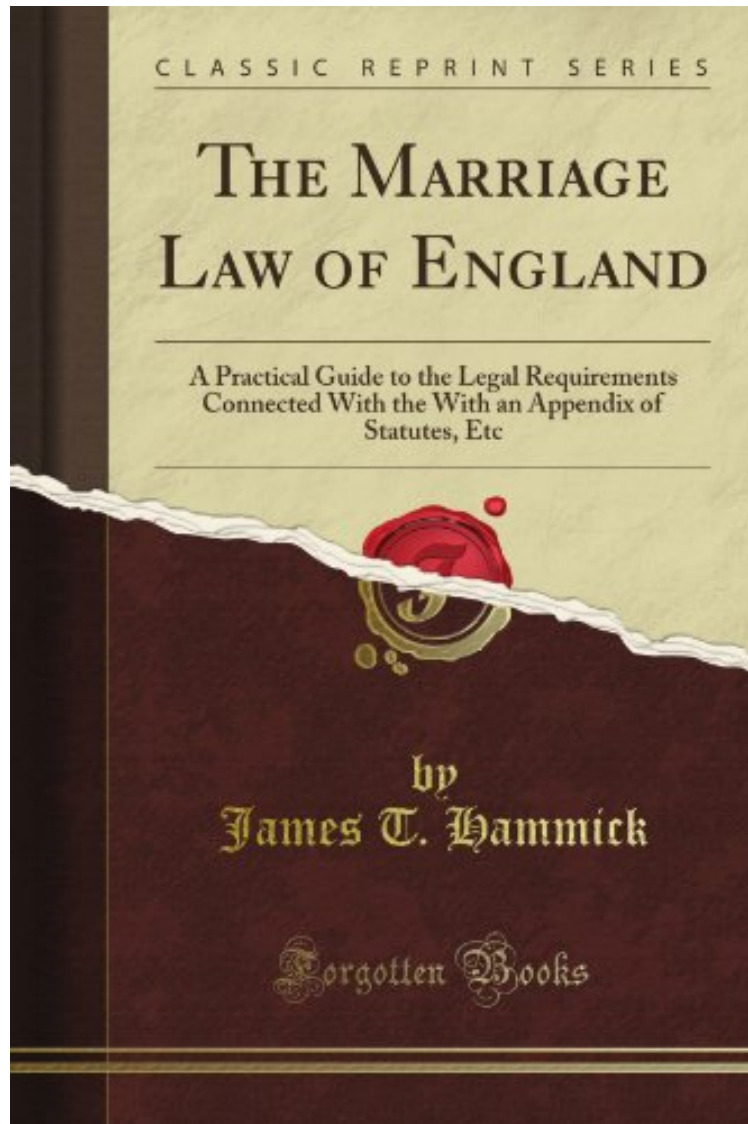

The following work is intended to supply, what the author has long felt to be a desideratum, a Manual of the law regulating the formation of the Marriage Contract, adapted to serve as a guide to those who are charged with public functions in connection with this important subject. While the Statute Book contains nearly thirty Acts relating to Marriages in England, and the present system of amending and partially repealing statutes renders the prospect of consolidation more remote than ever, the attempt to reduce into a systematic arrangement the provisions of the existing law will not be deemed a useless task: and it must be admitted that there is no branch of law which more immediately concerns the welfare and peace of society. It is natural that an inquiry into the Marriage Laws of the United Kingdom, extending over three years, and conducted by a Royal Commission composed of eminent statesmen and lawyers, should be frequently referred to in the following pages. Since the Commissioners made their Report in 1868, an important modification of the Law of Marriage has taken place in Ireland, and certain mixed marriages in that country will no longer be null and void.
