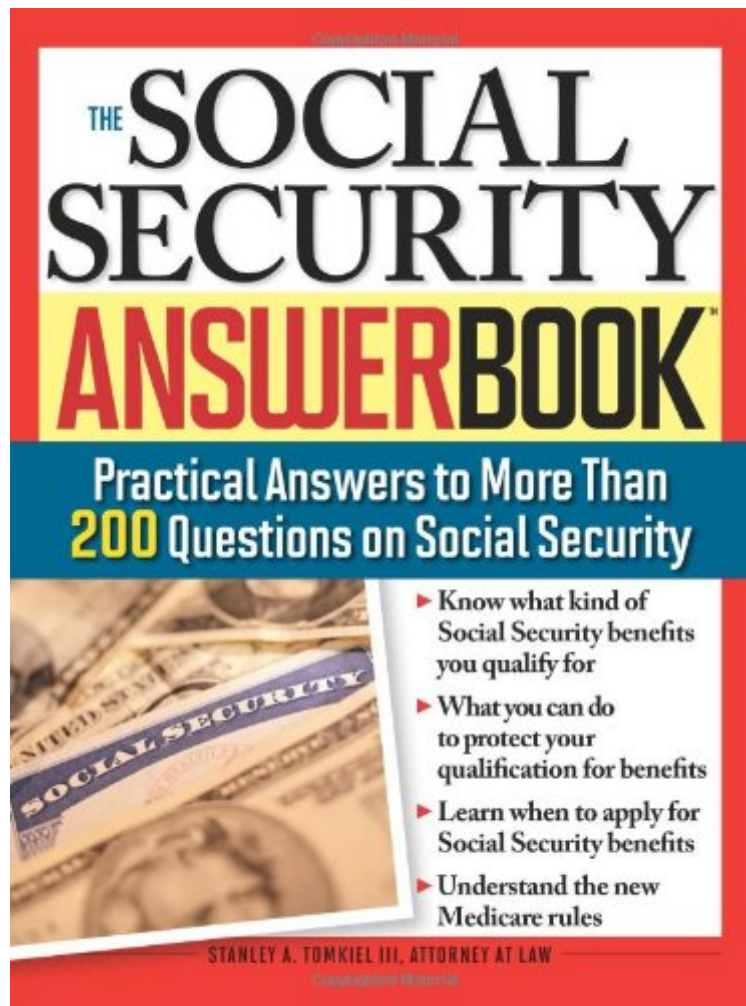

It has a lot of information but the Q/A format makes it a difficult read.The Questions are divided into topical sections/Chapters: Retirement, Disability, Survivor Benefits, MediCare, Spouse Benefits, Children, Applying for SS, Benefit Payments, Paying SS Tax and Identity Theft. And many of the answers are

repeated in different sections and sometimes in the same section making it redundant. The author is clearly very knowledgeable and experienced in working in the social security system. I would have preferred the information written as narrative text using SS Facts from the questions the author has accumulated and maybe using a few Questions to illustrate salient points. Unless the question YOU have matches the ones he has answered it won't help you much. In fact you might end up with more questions than answers.
