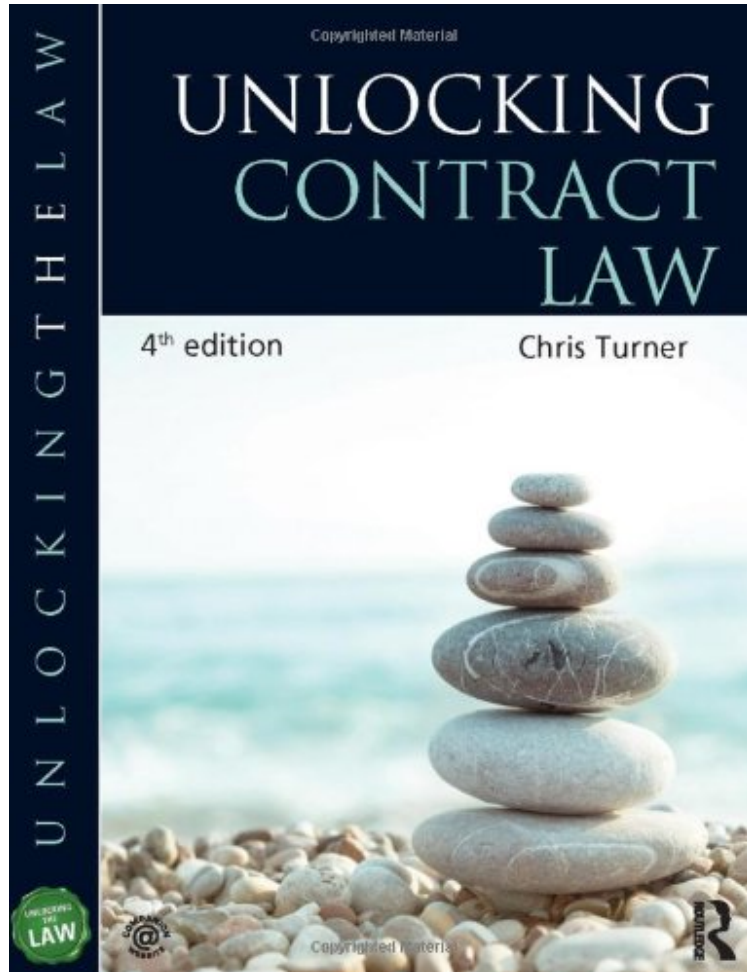

However, I would like to notify that on page 325-326 Case Example "Nash v Inman [1908] 2 KB 1, there is a typo."A Cambridge undergraduate, the son of an architect, was supplied with clothes the contract was still held to be enforceable "I believe that the correct version should be " the contract was still held to be unenforceable".According to the judgement at both Trial Court and Court of Appeal, the case was decided against the claimant, since the minor was adequately supplied with clothes, they did not find the supply of clothes by the tailor to be classed as "necessary".
