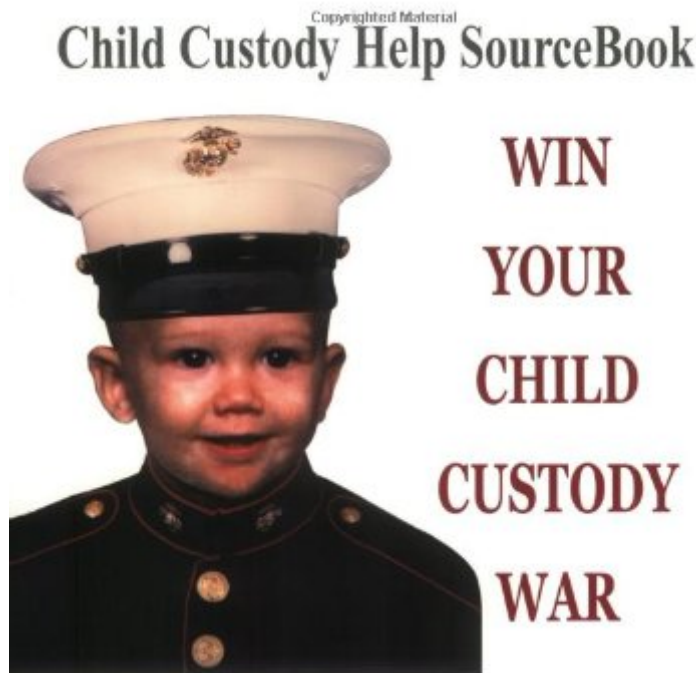

war"!By MMMhouseI'm not an attorney, but I'm practically becoming one as I prepare to represent myself in (what several mediators/judges have already commented is "the most contentious custody dispute [I/we]'ve dealt with in..." 10-20 years". (Disheartening and not constructive comments, but that's not the point of this review :)I would regard this as a more comprehensive glossary - it's even arranged as such. The title and frankly pretty creepy image on the cover of a baby dressed in a marines outfit gave me the false impression that this was a true "legal strategy" book. At best, and to stick with the military theme the book is written in (and sorry, but that gets old about 2% of the way in), these are definitions of tactical moves, with advice like "here's 3 pages about how your opponent will lie, lots of all caps thrown in for emphasis, but as General Patton said [he didn't, to my knowledge, and neither did the book - just trying to give a semi-realistic example of style and content!], let your enemy play dirty, but you should take the high road and never lie!"I'm not advocating lying. But this doesn't get into the more complex issues like - well what if your opposing counsel lies? What if the other side has convinced dozens of people to lie too? Sure, thanks for the advice my parents instilled in me since I was born - but legally, \*what can you really do when the judge reads 100s of pages of fabricated testimony from the other side? How do you neutralize that? Do you address each and every lie (running the risk of the entire case being pushed to the side as "high drama he said she said")? Do you pick a select few to address? Do you hire an investigator to disprove some? Or would that backfire and make you susceptible to charges of stalking??\*Most importantly, and to sum up the above - what do judges care about and what is the easiest, most convincing way to show that the opposing side spends most of their time/energy devising dirty tactics, and how can YOU prove that you don't stoop to that level and waste time addressing false allegations because you're the parent more concerned in your child's wellbeing??Considering this book was \$120 used, and to return it cost \$15 out of pocket, this was something in hindsight I should have tried harder to find in the library.Or simply taken a glance at the cover and determined that any book author/publisher who intentionally put a baby dressed in a marine outfit is probably not going to be the type of legal research resource that a self-represented parent is going to find secret answers to help defeat the other parent (who is an attorney and has the money to hire one as well), who hasn't to date let the code of professional conduct and ethics of the state bar association stand in the way of perjury - so hoping the other parent is living up to the standards of battle and professional conduct of a US marine is a lost cause.I like the glossary format, it truly is comprehensive and covers more than the basic statutes - definitions in plain terms, includes topics like lying (not covered in official West Law stuff you can find in the law library).I would have kept it as a reference resource if the price had a decimal point moved to the left - \$12 used, not \$120 used.0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
